## KAL The Thinking Shawl & YARN EXCHANGE

Come and join us! Please sign up so we can be prepared!

The Thinking Eye Shawl is knitted with **six 1 oz -95 yards skeins of sock yarn**. So, we thought that called for a yarn exchange. Gather up all your leftover sock yarns and join us. We'll trade colors so we all get our perfect six colors. Bring your size 6 needles and we'll get started.

This pattern was inspired by the painter, Paul Klee. We will have a number of prints of his work at the kick-off meetings for your color inspiration. I think this is the one that inspired this shawl.



In this KAL, you will learn the basics of intarsia color work, a self-finishing i-cord edge and effective ways of carrying yarns up the edge to minimize the number of ends that need to be woven into the shawl.

We have scrubbed the pattern adding handy notes and info to make the experience easier. This is really an easy pattern, you can all do this one!
